Looking up past your eyebrows, you should see the very edge of the helmet.</li> <li>Ears. The straps should meet right under your earlobes.</li> <li>Mouth. When buckled, the strap should be loose enough so you can breathe and insert two fingers between it and your chin, but tight enough that if you drop your jaw you can feel the helmet pull down on the top of your head.</li> </ul>
