

ASTHMA EDUCATOR INSTITUTE

The Asthma Educator Institute[™] (AEI) is a two-day preparatory course for individuals that want to implement asthma guidelines-based care and those qualified to take the National Asthma Educator Certification Board (NAECB) examination. The AEI was developed with experts in the field with asthma and it reflects the National Institute of Health, Expert Panel Report 3: Guidelines for the Diagnosis and Management of Asthma. AEI is a professional education course that targets frontline healthcare professionals, such as:

- Nurses
- Nurse Practitioners
- Respiratory Therapists
- Physicians
- Physician Assistants
- Pharmacists
- Masters Prepared or CHES Health Educators
- Social Workers
- AE-C's preparing for recertification

The curriculum aligns with the National Asthma Educator Certification (NAECB) Candidate handbook and includes case reviews, hands-on skills demonstrations, and practice.

- Describe patient and family assessments related to educational needs.

- Describe medications used in asthma management.
- Observe and demonstrate selected procedures in asthma assessment and care.
- Assess barriers to adherence for patients and families and identify strategies to address them
- Discuss steps in the development, implementation and evaluation of an asthma management plan.
- Identify components of asthma program evaluation and professional best practices
- Prepare to take the National Asthma Educator Certification Board Examination
