ASSIGNMENT DETAILS:

Your bike shop will be available to all Trekkers for maintenance on their bikes during the Trek. You may be required to make repairs to bicycles, to sell merchandise for Trekker use, or to assist with other mechanical problems. Trekkers have been informed that labor is free, but parts are charged to them.

- 3. Set up your tent, equipment and supplies in the designated area at the rest stop or finish line.
