ASSIGNMENT DETAILS:

Luggage crew member will load and unload luggage daily on their assigned 16' box truck. The luggage driver will transport luggage in their truck to and from each overnight facility. Drivers have been asked to assist with loading and unloading.

****Luggage bags are heavy. Some lifting (up to 25lbs) is required. Please ensure that each bag is properly tagged by the Trekker. They receive color/number coded tags for each of their bags (2 for dorms, 3 for campers).***

Luggage crew member has the option to coordinate with their assigned luggage driver either to ride along with them in the truck for the weekend or to drive their own vehicle. These plans should be coordinated between you and your assigned truck driver. **If you choose to ride together, please remember to coordinate where to leave your car and how you will get back to it at the end of the weekend.**

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- Overnight housing (dorm bed) is provided for each luggage crew member. You will also receive a commemorative t-shirt and meals for the duration of the weekend.
- The luggage team typically meets on Thursday evening, June 15, prior to Trek weekend. Your lead volunteer, Anne, will be in touch via email with specific details.
