



## RIDING POLICE TASK DESCRIPTION

### LOCATIONS + ASSIGNMENT TIMES:

<b>Friday, June 16</b>	Along the Trek route. 7:00am - 3:00pm (depart in intervals)
<b>Saturday, June 17</b>	Along the Trek route. 7:00am - 3:00pm (depart in intervals)
<b>Sunday, June 18</b>	Along the Trek route. 7:00am - 3:00pm (depart in intervals)

### ASSIGNMENT DETAILS:

#### On the Route:

- Depart at scheduled intervals to be evenly dispersed among the Trek riders along the route.
- Observe and enforce the rules of the road and safe riding habits among cyclists.
- Provide an overall safety presence as part of the Trek riding group. This can include being a visible safety presence for motorists along the route, as well as cyclists.

#### Communication:

- There will be a communication protocol in place for riding police, motorcycle police, and additional safety volunteer groups for dealing with incidents and emergencies.
- Protocol will be shared with you and discussed in full prior to Trek weekend.

### ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- You get the full Trek experience with no fundraising minimum requirement or registration fee.
- Overnight housing from Thursday - Saturday (if necessary).
- Commemorative volunteer t-shirt.
- Meals daily from Thursday - Sunday.
