



TREK SAFETY PATROL TASK DESCRIPTION

LOCATIONS + ASSIGNMENT TIMES:

Friday, June 16 Trek Route (depart in scheduled time intervals)
7:00am - 4:00pm

Saturday, June 17 Trek Route (depart in scheduled time intervals)
7:00am - 4:00pm

Sunday, June 18 Trek Route (depart in scheduled time intervals)
7:00am - 4:00pm

ASSIGNMENT DETAILS:

- You will be riding, observing, and educating cyclists about the “Rules of the Road” during the Trek ride.
- Inform Trekkers of inappropriate behaviors and the consequences to other cyclists.
- Assist in the event that another cyclist is in distress.
- Study all safety related materials regarding “Rules of the Road”.
- Report any inappropriate cyclist or team behaviors to Trek staff at the end of each day.

You will receive a yellow safety sash to be worn each day while cycling. This will allow you to be easily identified. You will also receive a Trek Safety Patrol Supply Packet.

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- Your volunteer materials will be given to you by your volunteer lead on Thursday, June 15, in Brunswick during the Trek Safety Patrol meeting.
- Check-in with Trek staff/volunteers to receive all of your official Trek information (number, luggage tags, etc.).
