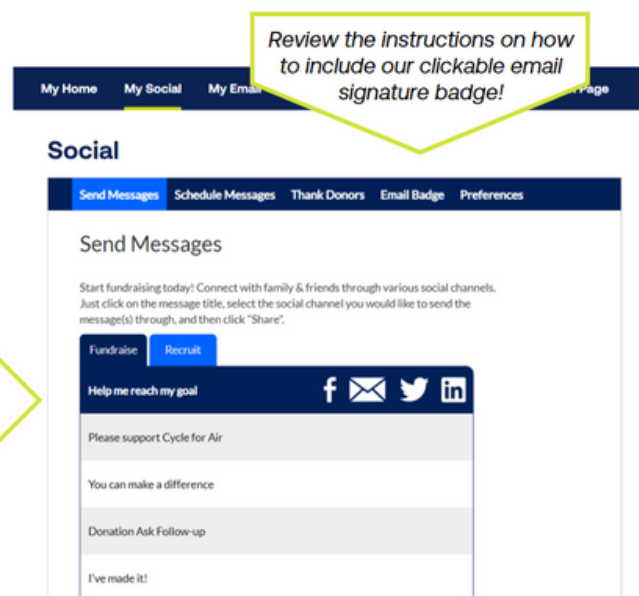
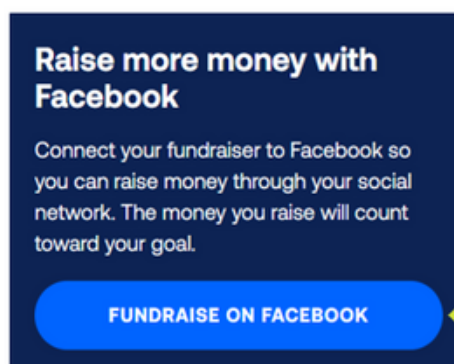

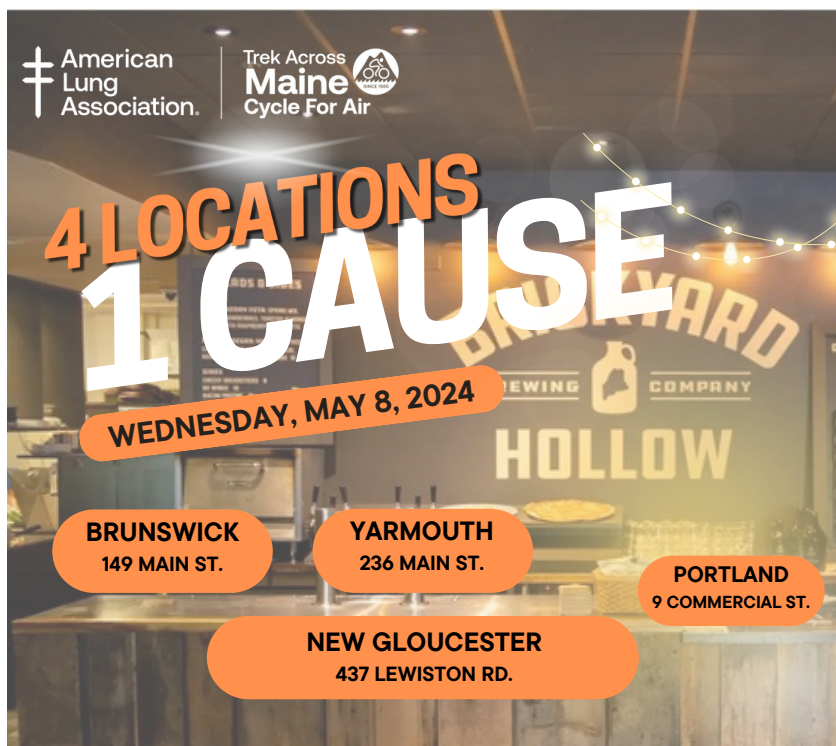
APRIL CYCLE SHORTS
