#### >>> BIKE REPAIRS & MECHANICAL SUPPORT



# Maine MISSION

Our work in the legislature continues as we take on the tobacco industry and their efforts to hook our kids on their deadly products. Over the past few months we have kept you engaged and asked for your help in Augusta and we still need your voice! We know that the industry is doing all they can to keep our kids addicted to nicotine – and the photo above is only the latest example. The latest disposable vape pen being marketed to kids bears a striking resemblance to the "Diary of a Wimpy Kid" book series that is popular with elementary students.



Just last month another Maine community has stepped up and enacted a local ordinance to end the sale of all flavored tobacco products now our state lawmakers need to do the same to protect all Maine kids from Kittery to Madawaska! Please take 30 seconds and click on the link to send a note to your legislator asking them to support LD 1215.

As the photo shows, the tobacco industry will do anything it can to hook a new generation of kids, using high doses of nicotine, thousands of kid-friendly flavors, and cheap prices. This public health emergency threatens decades of progress in lowering youth tobacco use.
