Workshop Description:

The COPD Educator Course is designed for healthcare professionals in a clinical or hospital setting. The day-and-a-half course covers a variety of topics on COPD: overview of the disease, pulmonary function testing, management of the condition, tobacco cessation, medication and oxygen therapy guidelines, pulmonary rehabilitation, and more.

Objectives:

The participant will be able to:

- 1. Discuss prevalence, risk factors and prevention strategies associated with COPD.
- 2. Discuss the role of pulmonary function testing for the identification and management of COPD.
- 3. Discuss the management of COPD in its various stages.
- 4. Discuss the 5 A's of tobacco cessation.
- 5. Describe oxygen therapy devices currently available.
- 6. Review the role of pulmonary rehabilitation in improving daily activities for the COPD patient.
- 7. Demonstrate proper technique for delivery of inhaled medications using a variety of devices.
- 8. Explain how education and self-management skills can improve quality of life for the COPD patient.
- 9. Describe hospital and community services available to assist the COPD patient and family with end of life issues.
