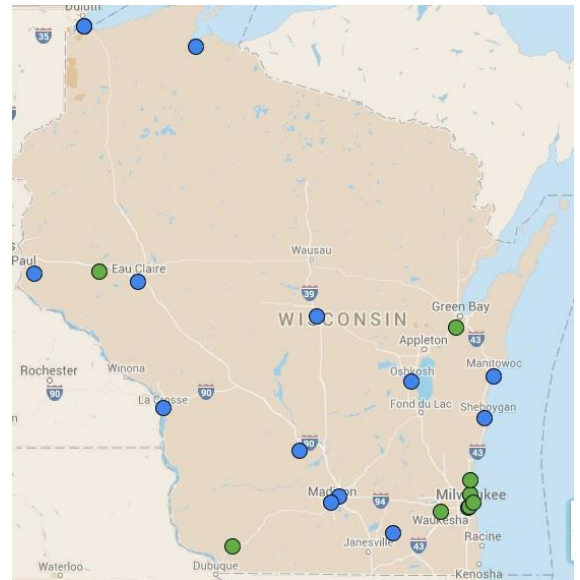

- Participate in earned media activities

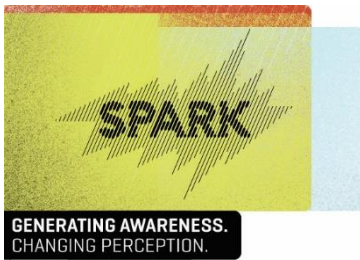
